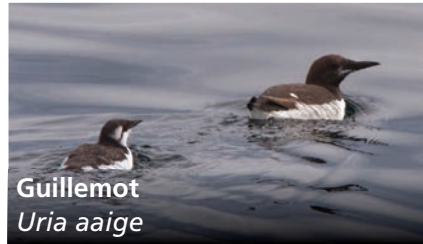

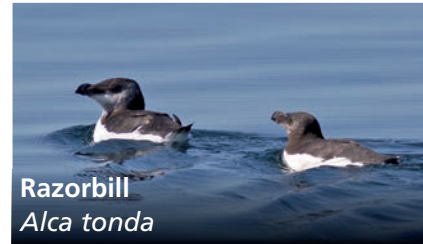

PUFFINS

Puffins breed at Staffa from mid April until late July. They nest in burrows on the cliff edges (shown as blue dots), north and south of the grassy hill marked here. Puffins spend most of their lives on the sea but may come ashore for visitors with patience and a bit of luck. The walk from the top of the stairs at the landing is about 400m and over a rough track. Please tell us if you don't think you'll manage and we may be able to take you to see them from the boat.
